Fixed Rate FTI Satellite Internet Service

PURPOSE: To provide FTI Satellite Internet customers a flexible cost effective Internet service that is billed at a fixed monthly rate with industry Fair Access Policy options.

- ***NO MINIMUM CHARGE!***
- ***NO LIMIT OF DATA DOWNLOADS OR UPLOADS***
- ***NO INTERNET SERVICE BILLING REPORTING REQUIREMENTS!***
- ***FIXED RATE PLAN***
 - 12 month minimum agreement term with increments of one year.
 - Customer declares average download and upload per month [GBytes] without minimum or maximum limitations.
 - FTI billing at a discounted rate for committed download and upload volume
 - The total amount of download data transfer measured in Mbytes multiplied by \$.01 PLUS the total amount of upload data transfer measured in Mbytes multiplied by \$.02.
 - “Fair Access Policy” or “FAP” actions will be initiated as per the customer option when the month to date daily average uploads or downloads exceed the declared monthly commitment.
 - **OPTION “A”** - Customer has the option of having the data transfer rate decreased to 56 kbps download and 16 kbps upload until such time that the average month to date uploads and downloads are consistent with the declared monthly commitment; or
 - **OPTION “B”** - Customer has the option of paying for the accumulated FAP data downloaded and uploaded at a rate of \$.20 per MByte at the end of the month.
 - **OPTION “C”** – Customer may option to “Roll Over” unused MBytes into a “Bank” of unused download and upload of committed Mbytes. FAP condition will utilize Banked Mbytes rather than incur either a network data rate decrease or charges until such time that the Banked Mbytes have been completely used at which time FAP charges of \$.02 for download Mbytes and \$.04 for upload Mbytes will apply.
 - Fixed Rate Plan agreement changes with regard to both monthly data commitment and FAP options may be changed by Customer in writing at least 30 days in advance of the next billing cycle (first day of each month).
